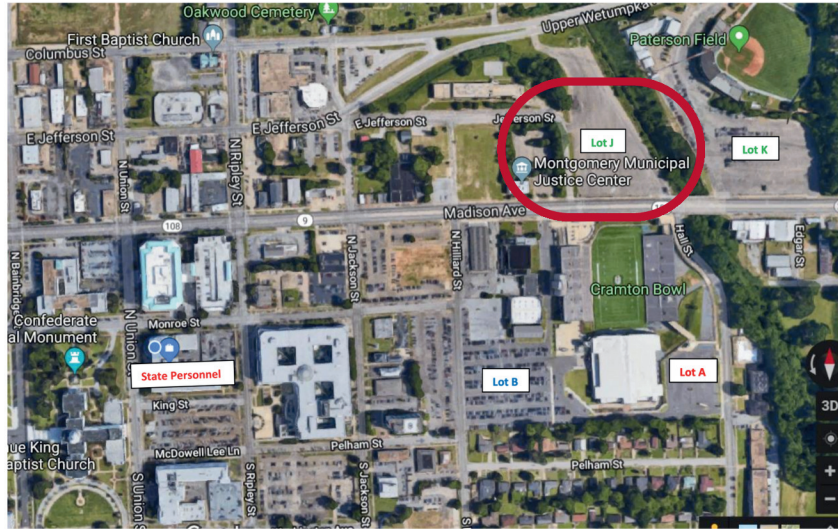


# AEA DAY AT THE STATE HOUSE | **KNOW BEFORE YOU GO**

- FREE parking is available in **LOT J** near Cramton Bowl, 1022 Madison Avenue, Montgomery, AL 36104. You'll see signage directing you to the parking area. Montgomery County Public School Buses will be available to transport you from the parking lot to the lawn of the Alabama Archives Building beginning at 7:15 a.m.



- Registration begins at 7:30 a.m., on the lawn of the Alabama Department of Archives and History Building, located at 624 Washington Avenue, Montgomery, AL 36104. Participants will check in and receive their shirts, talking points, and refreshments.
- After the welcome and overview of talking points, participants will walk to the Alabama State House to meet with their legislators. You will have to go through a security checkpoint to enter the building. ***To ensure a smooth entry, please do not bring any weapons, nail files, or similar items.***
- A group photo will be taken on the steps of the Alabama Department of Archives and History at 11:15 a.m. After the group picture, lunch will be provided under the tent. Buses will be available to transport participants back to LOT J to their vehicles.
