SUBJECT: Future Teachers of Alabama (FTA) Program Director Stipend Grant REVISED

Enclosed is the Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 Future Teachers of Alabama (FTA) Program Director Stipend Grant application and budget. The purpose of the grant is to support FTA programs by providing \$1,000 for teachers to serve as FTA program directors in each Alabama senior high school with Grades 9-12 and/or to fund chapter activities.

A maximum of 250 grants of \$1,000 each will be awarded. Funds are available for obligation from October 1, 2023, through September 30, 2024. The deadline to submit this grant is Tuesday, September 19, 2023, at 4:30 p.m. Please send applications to Mrs. Kayla Cantley, Education Specialist for Career and Technical Education/Workforce Development, Alabama State Department of Education, P. O. Box 302101, Montgomery, Alabama 36130-2101.

Once the grant is approved, payment by the local education agency to the FTA program director shall be made for \$1,000 less the required employer and employee match for applicable fringe benefits and any expended program activities.

1. Divide the \$1,000 by 1.2024 (1+the total benefit rates) *Take out LEA portion first!

- 2. This equals \$832 (Supplement amount that teacher will get as gross pay)
- 3. Algebra with X as supplement amount:

X + .2024X = 1000

1.2024X = 1000X = 1000/1.2024

$$X = 1000/1$$

X = 832

*This is the normal process, so the LEA will not have to use their own funds to cover their portion of the payroll taxes.

4. Check by adding \$832 plus benefits to make sure it equals 1,000. (832 + 168 = 1,000)
